

This autumn, you may have seen preparations to install semi-buried “CSE” waste containers in the village.

These containers have been put in place in recent days and you are welcome to use them to dispose of the following rubbish: **household waste (“OM”)**, **recyclable packaging (“Tri”)** and **glass (“Verre”)**.

Reminder: recyclable packaging denotes paper, newspapers and magazines, food/milk cartons, bottles and plastic containers, small cardboard packets and steel and aluminium cans.

There are three waste disposal sites (“PAV”) in the commune with these new semi-buried containers (pictured below).



**Please note**: you can use any semi-buried waste bin in the 15 villages that make up the CCHC.

**From 14 December 2015, the CCHC will begin to remove the old “wheelie-bins” and the above-ground recycling and glass bins.**

**This being so, we would be grateful if you would no longer use the old bins for household waste and recycling, and instead use the new semi-buried facilities!**

Other types of waste (cardboard, heavy goods, metal products, wood...) should be taken to Morzine tip (this is closest to La Côte d'Arbroz), open Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 7pm. You may also choose to use any other CCHC-run tips.

Please request a tip card from the CCHC to use the five available tips (access is not possible without it).
